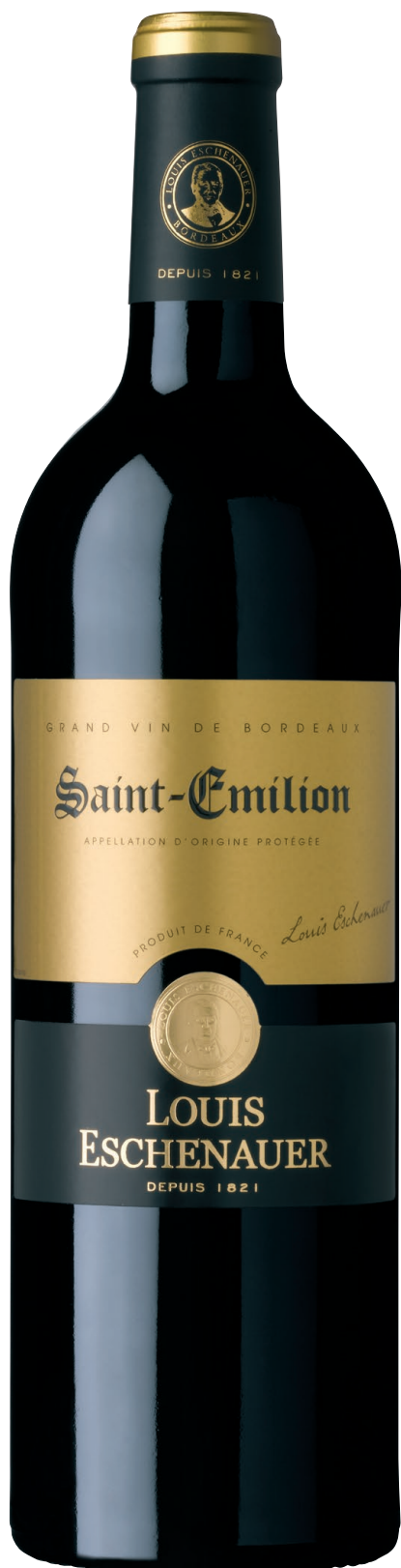

GRAND VIN DE BORDEAUX

SAINT-ÉMILION AOP

GRAPE VARIETIES: 95% Merlot and 5% Cabernet franc.

LOCATION: The Saint-Émilion vineyard is a region close to the famous town of the same name, a UNESCO world heritage site, located on the right bank of Bordeaux. Saint-Émilion is an important Bordeaux appellation, producing some of the world's most famous wines. The town of Saint-Émilion is as famous for its wines as it is for its architectural heritage.

VINIFICATION: This wine is made traditionally in stainless steel vats. The process is very long and lasts between 2 and 3 weeks. Once the vinification is finished, the wine is aged and devatted every 3 months.

SOIL: Clay-calcareous and clay-sand hillsides.

TASTING NOTES:

COLOUR: Pretty garnet with ruby red tints.

BOUQUET: A subtle aromatic nose of almond and rose with a hint of red berries.

TASTE: A finish that is elegant and fruity whilst displaying light spicy notes.

SERVING SUGGESTION: This wine will enhance your red meats, jugged dishes, game, traditional veal chops as well as your cheeses and even wild strawberry tarts.

SERVING TEMPERATURE: 16 to 18 °C.

LAY DOWN FOR: 7 to 15 years.
